



LOOKING TO STAY WITH US?

HERE'S EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW, WHETHER IT'S CAMPING OR GLAMPING!

WHAT'S PROVIDED ON SITE FOR ALL GUESTS?

Whether you are camping or glamping here at Castle Knights, all guests have access to the following shared communal areas and equipment:

- **Toilet block** just steps from your accommodation, with hot showers, modern loos with hand towels, toilet roll and soap provided. (Please be mindful of other guests and not take extra long showers)
- **Fully equipped kitchen block** with fridge, freezers, gas hobs, microwaves, toasters, kettles and drinking water. (There is no boiler in the kitchen for hot water, so please use the kettles provided to boil water for washing up.) **Important to note, there is no working oven in the kitchen.**
- **Some pans, pots, cutlery and other cooking utensils** are provided within the kitchen area for all guests to share also.
- **2 large fire pits for communal use with benches.** (You can bring your own wood for this or purchase some from us, this is £5 a bag and can be added on at the time of booking.)
- **Undercover rainy day room** with some games, comfy chairs and some reading materials.
- **BBQ Hut** - So you can BBQ whatever the weather! (This is for all guests to share so please be considerate of others)
- **Electric lighting** within the communal kitchen, toilets and BBQ Hut.
- **Low voltage sockets** within the communal kitchen (these can only handle low voltage items like phone charging)
- **Stocks** - for restraining naughty children or adults!

WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING WITH YOU

Whether you are camping or glamping here at Castle Knights, here are some essentials you should bring:

- **Towels**
- **Food and drink** - Usk town centre is only a short walk from the campsite, with numerous pubs and restaurants as well as a well stocked Co-op, so feel free to shop there too!
- **Torch** - There is little lighting on the campsite field, so we recommend bringing a torch for after dark!



- **Warm clothes and waterproof clothing** - With the glorious Welsh weather, you'll never know when you might need this.
- **Wellies** (just in case!)
- **Sleeping bags and bedding** - If you have booked silver standard glamping or are camping.
- **BBQ** - If you'd like to bring your own BBQ, these are allowed but **please ensure these are kept off the ground at all times.**

IMPORTANT TO NOTE

We are an off-grid campsite, there is no internet on the campsite.

THE ABOVE IS THE BASICS, SEE BELOW FOR CAMPING AND GLAMPING SPECIFIC INFORMATION.

CAMPING

We have a total of **7 camping pitches for tents and 2 campervan pitches** on site, each pitch is located on our campsite field alongside some of the glamping accommodation we also offer.

If you'd like to stay as part of a group booking, we can also accommodate this, just drop us an email to ensure we have the space and we can place you all together.

Please see further information about our camping offerings below:

- Our camping pitches are per tent and can accommodate tents **up to 4m x 4m as a standard**, allowing for a **total of 6 guests** per pitch.
- Larger tents can be accommodated, but **please add on the "XL TENT"** at booking (this is £10), as we may need to adjust our offerings to other guests for your stay.
- We allow adults and children, **adults pay per night and children pay per stay**. Children will need to be added as extras when booking. We do not charge for children under 5.
- We can accommodate **two campervans or tent boxes on site**, please ensure these are booked under the campervan pitch for your stay.
- We do allow dogs but **please ensure dogs are on a lead at all times** and please clean up after your dog. Dogs must be child and dog friendly as the castle grounds are home to children and a site dog. **We allow one dog per booking, please let us know at booking if you are bringing a dog.**



SOME EXTRAS YOU MIGHT WANT TO ADD

- **ELECTRIC HOOK UP** - We have electric hook ups available to the tent and campervan pitches, these are £5 per stay and need to be added at booking.
We provide a 16 amp outdoor socket for campers to plug into, you will need to bring your own plug and lead. *LOW VOLTAGE ITEMS ONLY - E.G PHONE CHARGING*
- **GAZEBO** - There is the ability to add a gazebo (less than 3m x 3m) next to your tent or campervan. **Please add Gazebo at booking** this is £10.
We cannot accommodate larger than 3m x 3m structures as our site is only small and we need the space for other campers.
- **AWNING SPACE** - If you need additional space for an awning to your campervan or vehicle (if bringing a tent box), please add this at booking. This is £5
- **LOGS** - If you'd like to make use of the communal fire pits on site, we have logs available for you to purchase. These are £5 a bag and can be added at booking.

GLAMPING

We have a total of **7 glamping accommodation units here at Castle Knights**, each unit is unique and offers various sleeping arrangements. Most are located alongside the camping pitches on the campsite field, with two of them being a bit closer to the castle walls.

Each glamping unit comes with low voltage power sockets, lighting and some additional extras within. **Be aware the sockets can only handle small low voltage items and phone charging.**

Please see further information about our glamping offerings below:

- Our glamping accommodation is unique, **with each one offering something a little different**, be sure to read the specific information for each unit.
- We allow dogs **in some** of the glamping accommodations; **The Nook, Glyndwr Fort and Shepherds Cabin** all allow dogs. Please ensure dogs are **on a lead at all times** and please clean up after your dog. **Dogs must be child and dog friendly** as the castle grounds are home to children and a site dog.



- **All glamping units come as silver standard**, this means we provide pillows, pillowcases and a bottom sheet. So you can bring your own sleeping bags or duvets to sleep in.

AN EXTRA YOU MIGHT WANT TO ADD

- **GOLD STANDARD BEDDING** - If you'd like us to provide all the bedding for your stay, so you don't have to worry! Please add "Gold Standard Bedding to your booking. We'll provide all bedding, with some extra throws for your stay to keep you nice and cosy. **Price is £10 per person** and easy to add.

THE YURT

Sleeps 4 (1 double and 2 singles)

Electric lighting, low voltage plug sockets and DAB radio.

Outdoor decking and chairs.





GLYNDWR FORT

Sleeps 4 (1 double and 2 singles in bunk beds)

Electric lighting, low voltage plug sockets and DAB radio.

Outdoor decking and chairs.



SHEPHERDS CABIN

Sleeps 2 (and a space for a cot)

Electric lighting, low voltage plug sockets and DAB radio.

Wood burning stove and kitchen equipment.





THE DRAGONETTE

Sleeps 3 (1 double and 1 single bunk above)

Electric lighting, low voltage plug sockets and DAB radio.



TOM'S BARREL

Sleeps 3 (1 double and 1 small single)

LED lighting, low voltage plug sockets and fold out table.

Outdoor decking and chairs.





THE NOOK

Sleeps 2 (1 double bed)

Stable door, oak floor

Outdoor table and chairs



THE LODGE

Sleeps 2 (and a space for a cot)

Electric lighting, low voltage plug sockets and DAB radio.

Outdoor table and chairs

Tea and coffee making facilities





CASTLE KNIGHTS POLITE REQUESTS

Please see the below information with regards to our campsite:

- **Check in and out times** - Check in is from 2pm, with the latest check in being 7pm (if you need to turn up later, please email your request to info@castleknights.co.uk, and we can see if we can accommodate). Check out is at 11am.
- **Please email us your arrival time** - at info@castleknights.co.uk, so we can be there to greet you.
- **Parking** - Parking is provided within the main castle car park, all cars to be parked there. We do not allow cars to be parked alongside your pitch, unless you have booked a campervan pitch.
- **Unloading your vehicle** - There is a turning circle at the top of the site to drop items off and use the wheel barrows provided to move items to your pitch or glamping accommodation.
- **Please respect and consider other campsite guests** - Bear in mind visitors to Usk Castle and its residents i.e **Children should not be allowed into the Castle unattended.**
- **Entry to Usk Castle** - If Usk Castle is open during your stay, you are more than welcome to visit its grounds during daylight hours. **Access is not permitted during private events or at night.**
- **Be considerate of music/noise volume** - Please be aware of other campsite guests and castle residents. No loud or amplified music within the campsite after 10pm.
- **Only light fires in the firepits provided** - we are NOT insured for your own use near your tents or other campers.
- **Wash up any of our cutlery/crockery used** - Please ensure all items used are returned to the cupboards clean, for other guests to use.
- **Place all rubbish in bins provided** - Recycling card in red bags, plastic/metal/tin in purple bags, glass in green containers, food waste in blue caddy and general rubbish in black bags.
- **Close toilet and shower block doors** - After use, otherwise rain and creatures get in.
- **Any breakages/damage to be reported** - Please report any breakages and damage to Tom in person or on 07506099241, so we can make them right.
- **Clean up after your dog** - This is a family site, be mindful of those who may be fearful of dogs.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE

Usk Castle backs on to Castle Knights Campsite and the castle can be hired for private events, which means there may be some loud music during your stay.

Private events may have loud music (amplified or live band) till Midnight, then event guests will



be leaving the site for the hour after this. Requests are made to the hirer that all guests leave quietly so not to disturb our campsite guests.

If you'd like to ensure you are staying when an event IS NOT present, please check the USK CASTLE CALENDAR ahead of booking your stay. As all private events are in the calendar for your awareness.
